AI IMPACT FESTIVAL 2025



The AI Festival 2025 refers to several global events, but prominently features the **India AI Impact Festival 2025**, a major national initiative held on November 17–18, 2025, at the Dr. Ambedkar International Centre in New Delhi. Organized by the India AI Mission under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, this festival served as a pre-summit

event for the AI Impact Summit 2026, focusing on "AI Innovation for Social Impact". The event brought together students, educators, innovators, and industry leaders to showcase AI projects aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

The festival featured hands-on workshops, live demonstrations, and panel discussions on topics like sector-specific AI skilling and the role of AI in K-12 education. A key highlight was the opportunity for students to interact with an ISRO astronaut, Group

Captain Shubhanshu Shukla. The event also celebrated the felicitation of winners for their innovative, socially impactful AI solutions and the graduation of the first cohort from a data annotation course for underserved girl students. The festival successfully kindled curiosity among young learners and reinforced India's commitment to building an inclusive and future-ready AI ecosystem.
